Hello Extreme Team Guardians!

We are **excited** to welcome back or meet for the first time, your child/children on Thursday, September 10th, 2020!!!

This school start up will be like no other. We recognize that the transition to home learning that took place last March and the hybrid learning that followed were extremely challenging for all. Thank-you for your support and cooperation. We will all need to continue to work together and be patient as we take on this next challenge in student learning.

We were so impressed by the care and commitment our staff demonstrated all of last year, especially from Spring Vacation to the end of the year. Staff has been equally committed in preparing for the start of the 2020-2021 school year.

This school year will look different.

In order to have a safe first day we are taking precautions and are asking families to help us in the following ways!

1) Ensure you review the health check form and do **NOT** send your child if they are sick or have symptoms.

2) Allow yourself extra time as the usual school "drop and go" WILL NOT BE EFFECT September 10th!

Here is our plan:

In the late afternoon on Wednesday September 9th an email will be sent to families to let them know which Team their child is in and their designated entrance/exit is for their Team, starting September 10th.

On the morning of September 10, 2020, we will have all our staff outside at 14 different located at various areas on school grounds. These check-in points are

shown on the map below. Every staff member will have a copy of the school map, and the class lists for each team. From there students will guided to their designated entrance/exit for that Team.

Each staff check point will follow the following procedure:

- Students will be welcomed with a smile and a warm welcome back!
- Students will be asked to stop to answer the following questions.
 - o Do you know your Team?
 - o Do you know your exit/entrance spot?
- If the student is not clear on the two questions asked, staff will share the information
- The student will then be asked to line up behind a pylon with 6 feet of distancing between students until 4-6 students are in the line. At that time, one of the adults will escort the socially distanced line to their entrance/exit spot.
- We will continue this procedure until we have welcomed our students.
- Staff will then lead their Teams in through their specific entrance
- Ms. Moore and Mr. Hazlewood will be at the front of the school to welcome any late arrivals.
- If you can drop off your student away from the school so they walk onto the property, that would be appreciated.
