School Fees

We request a Student School Fee of \$45 for grade 6 students. This fee includes the Student Agenda which is mandatory for all Grade 6 students, Lock Rental, and Activity & Cultural fees. We request a Student School Fee of \$35 for grade 7/8 students. This fee includes the Lock Rental and Activity & Cultural fees. E-transfer to LWM@sd83.bc.ca is the preferred method of payment, but cash and cheques are also accepted at the office. The comment in the e-transfer MUST always include the student's name and the reason for funds (in this case, "Student First and Last Name & Student Fees").

If circumstances do not permit payment or will cause financial hardship, please call or email a confidential note to our Vice Principal – smitchel@sd83.bc.ca. We appreciate your attention to these fees and payment as soon as possible or by September 26, 2025.
